Pleasant and Main serves breakfast, weekend brunch, lunch and dinner (community supper) in a 110-year-old country store turned restaurant in the quaint village of Housatonic, minutes only from downtown Great Barrington.

The menu uses local produce and fresh ingredients and changes with the season.

Besides breakfast and brunch favorites, it also features French savory and sweet crepes and incorporates a European influence. The wooden shelves are lined with antiques and artefacts collected over 30 years, a 1907 courting canoe hangs from the ceiling.
